A Proprietary Blend Dry Red Table wine from Paso Robles, San Luis Obispo, Central Coast, California, USA

Denner's 2010 Ditch Digger wraps around the palate with layers of dark fruit. Tobacco, grilled herbs and leather appear later, adding complexity and nuance. This is a powerful, structured wine that needs at least another year in bottle. Ditch Digger is 40% Grenache, 30% Syrah, 20% Mourvedre, 5% Counoise and 5% Cinsault (vinified with 35% whole clusters) that spent 16 months in 500-liter French oak barrels, 35% new. Anticipated maturity: 2014-2020. I was deeply impressed with the wines I tasted from Denner this year. From top to bottom, these new releases capture the essence of everything that makes Paso Robles one of the most exciting wine making regions in the world. Tel. (805) 239-4287
